Domestic Students

- Undergraduate cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better
- Transcripts must be submitted
- Resume
- Personal Statement
- Two (2) letters of recommendation that highlight the candidate's academic potential from a previous professor, employer, or colleague (optional, at the discretion of each program)

International Students

- Undergraduate cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better
- Transcripts must be submitted
- A course-by-course evaluation of international transcripts is required; FAU will do the evaluation or it must be done by a NACES member
- TOEFL score of 500 or IBT of 61; IELTS 6.0; Duolingo 90
- Evidence of Professional Certification or eligibility for temporary certificate
- Resume
- Personal Statement
- Two (2) letters of recommendation that highlight the candidate's academic potential from a previous professor, employer, or colleague (optional, at the discretion of each program)
