- 9 Conduct: A "yes" answer to either of the conduct questions on the online application will require a written explanation. Additional information may be requested when your application is under review. Applications will not be fully processed until all conduct issues are cleared.
- 9 Application status: Once your application has been submitted, you can check your application status online to ensure transcripts and test scores have been received.
