### International Students

- Official transcripts from all undergraduate & graduate coursework
- Grade point average (GPA) of 3.00+ in the last 60 semester hours of undergraduate work 3.25+ in a completed master's degree program
- Professional statement of applicant's career goals, research interests, and rationale for entrance in to the doctoral program
- A curriculum vitae (CV) or resume
- Two (2) letters of recommendation from supervisors and/or professors speaking to applicant's scholarly interests and abilities
- A course -by-course evaluation of international transcripts is required; FAU will do the evaluation or it must be done by a NACES member
- TOEFL score of 500 (c)9 (a) ( 60 s)4. se1.6 (t)um (e)4 (se1-4.7 (r)-3s)2.3 (,)1 Tw4.7 (5,)1
