REGULATION TITLE AND NUMBER: Trespass and Loitering (7.006).

SUMMARY: Regulation 7.006, Trespass and Loitering, was last amended in November 1987 and requires amendment to conform with new administrative titles. Under Regulation 7.006 the Vice President for Financial Affairs acts as the President's designee to administer and policies outli
