### Florida Atlantic University

#### Regulation 7.004

This regulation should repealed as all of its provisions are either incorporated in other regulations or policies or are no longer applicable or needed.

#### Code of Penalties.

- (1) The following constitutes a uniform Code of Penalties for violation of rules at Florida Atlantic University not otherwise provided by law: The University is authorized to impose penalties for the following categories of infractiorulas:
- (a) Penalties for violation of standards of academic honesty, such as plagiarism, cheating, and other activities which interfere with the educational mission of the University. These penalties may range from counsetimexpulsion or termination.
- (b) Penalties for failure to pay debts owed the University. Penalties may range from the assessment of a penalty fee to withholding of official records or benefits.
- (c) Penalties for violation of standards of conduct for members of the faculty and staff. Penalties may range from oral reprimand to termination.
- (d) Penalties for violation of standards of conduct for students. Penalties may range from counseling expulsion.
- (e) Penalties for violation of employment contracts. Penalties may range them or reprimand to termination of contract.
- (f) Penalties for falsification of records. Penalties may range from oral reprimand to expulsion or termination.
  - (2) These remedies are not exclusive of other remedies provided under law.
