NOTICE OF PROPOSED REGULATION REPEAL

Date: July 6, 2012

REGULATION TITLE AND NUMBER: Disruptive Conduct (7.005).

SUMMARY: Regulation 7.005 describes types of disruptive conduct that are deemed to violate University standards for faculty, staff, and students. Regulation 7.005 is no longer necessary because other University Regulations and policies govern these areas more specifically. This repeal amendment shall be effective August 6, 2012.
